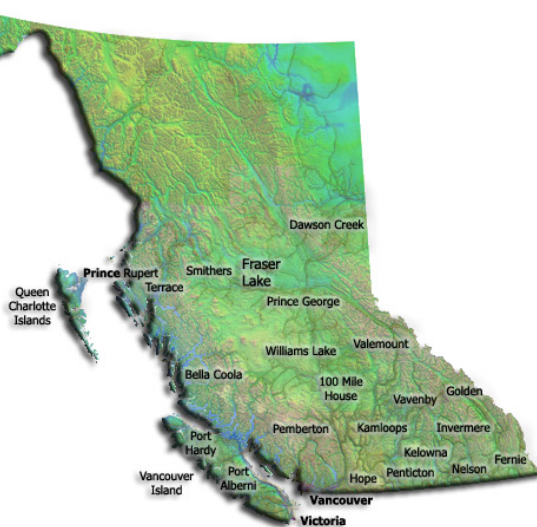

Marketing - Members will:
